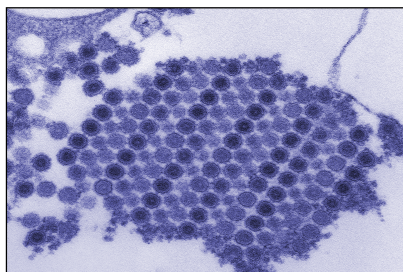


Chikungunya Virus Envelope 1 Protein Monoclonal

Chikungunya Virus is a small single stranded RNA virus. The virus is spread by the mosquito vectors *Aedes aegypti* and *Aedes albopictus*. Chikungunya infection can cause fever, headache, rash, and severe joint pain. The spread of the disease had been localized to the tropical belt (Sub-saharan Africa, South Asia, Southeast Asia, Central & South America) but cases are now found in the Caribbean and most recently the United States.
